And you will be taken to a wonderful **Kimono Museum** where masterpieces of Kimono dyed by Mr. **Kuobota Itchiku** who had succeeded in restoring the old dyeing method called 'Tsuji-gahana dyeing' are displayed.

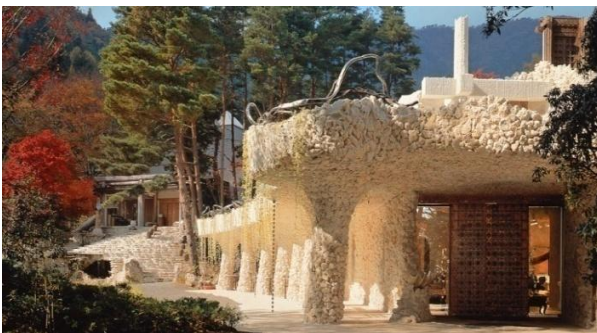


Itchiku World
